How many islands are in the British Indian Ocean territory?

What is the elevation of the British Indian Ocean territory?

The islands of the British Indian Ocean Territory feature flat and low terrain and most areas of the islands do not exceed more than 2 min elevation. There are no rivers and lakes on the islands. The ocean-side dunes on the Diego Garcia atoll are the highest point in the British Indian Ocean Territory, which rises to an elevation of only 9 m.

Are there any permanent settlements in the Indian Ocean territory?

There are no permanent settlements on the islands and the British Indian Ocean Territory is currently inhabited by about 4,000 US and UK military staff and contract personnel. It is administered from London by a Commissioner, who is appointed by the ruling British Monarch.

What is the climate like in the British Indian Ocean territory?

The island's climate is heavily moderated by the trade winds which blow over the islands. There are no permanent settlements on the islands and the British Indian Ocean Territory is currently inhabited by about 4,000 US and UK military staff and contract personnel.
