

# Can i close the switch if the energy storage light is not on

What does it mean when a light switch is closed?

If there is any source or charged capacitors present in it then a current starts flowing as soon as the switch is closed. It basically means when u switch on a light on you are actually switching off the internal circuit so as to let the bulb on. See also How do you calculate force from momentum?

What happens if a switch is closed?

A closed switch is equivalent to short circuit; hence it has the resistance of zero. When the switches are closed the total circuit resistance will be? If the switch is closed, the  $R_2$  resistance becomes non-factor and you have less resistance, which will cause you to have higher current. What is short circuit in simple words?

What happens if a switch is 'on' or 'off'?

When a switch is in the 'on' position it allows the electricity flow to enter the main electrical circuit and the circuit becomes a closed circuit. On the other hand, when a switch is in the 'off' position it blocks the electricity flow from entering the main electrical i and the circuit becomes an open circuit.

What is a closed switch?

A closed switch is one that provides a direct (low resistance) path for current to flow through. How do you find the current when the switch is closed? Can a circuit work without a switch?

Can a power switch run without a circuit plugged in?

No. With nothing plugged in there is no circuit, so no current can flow. An exception to this is if the socket or the switch has an indicator light - usually a neon one - that is illuminated when the switch is on. In that case the light will use a (very small) amount of power.

What is the difference between open and closed switch?

The terms "open" and "closed" are used to describe both switches and whole circuits. An open switch is one that has no continuity, meaning that no current can flow through it. A closed switch allows the current to flow in a direct (low resistance) path. Which switch when closed will cause a short circuit? What will happen after closing the switch?
