What percentage of Central African adults have a bank account?

The Global Financial Index shows that 13.7 percent of Central African adults had access to a bank account in 2017, up from 3.3 percent in 2011. Despite this impressive improvement, the level of access to finance remains low and-- below the average of CEMAC countries (36 percent).

The Central African Republic is one of the world's least-developed countries, with over 60 percent of its population living in poverty. The country does have some important natural resources, with timber and diamonds dominating exports. However, transportation and the electrical infrastructure is extremely limited.
