The British government agreed Thursday to hand sovereignty of the long-contested Chagos Islands, an archipelago of more than 60 islands in the Indian Ocean, to Mauritius, in a deal to secure the future of a strategically important U.K.-U.S. military base.

Why did the UK agree to the Chagos Islands?

It said the status agreement secured the long-term status of a strategic military facility used by both British and US forces on the largest island of Diego Garcia. The UK began negotiations over the Chagos Islands, also known as the British Indian Ocean Territory, in 2022. Why did the UK agree to this?

When was the British Indian Ocean Territory established?

Formerly administered as part of the British Crown Colony of Mauritius, the British Indian Ocean Territory (BIOT) was established as an overseas territory of the UK in 1965. A number of the islands of the territory were later transferred to the Seychelles when it attained independence in 1976.

How many islands are in the British Indian Ocean territory?
