

# Energy storage is attached to power plants

What are energy storage systems (ESS) in nuclear power plants?

Energy storage systems (ESS) that are integrated with nuclear power plants (NPP) serve multiple purposes. They not only store excess energy generated during off-peak periods but also effectively manage fluctuating energy demand and mitigate safety concerns. Integrated ESS nuclear power plant yields a higher capacity factor.

How do energy storage stations work?

In this mode, new energy power plants form a consortium to jointly invest in and build an energy storage station. Once the energy storage station is constructed, it operates as an independent entity, serving multiple new energy power plants that participated in the investment.

Do fossil fuel power plants need storage?

It is observed in Fig. 7 that storage is needed only when 30% or more of the currently produced energy from fossils is substituted. When the entire energy produced by the fossil fuel power plants is substituted, the storage system capacity is substantial, at approximately 12 million m<sup>3</sup>.

What is shared energy storage?

In the shared mode, the energy storage is collectively owned by a consortium of new energy power plants, with the individual plants within the consortium serving as the users. Due to these differences in ownership and usage rights across the modes, the energy storage configuration schemes also differ.

What is energy storage?

Energy storage is the capturing and holding of energy in reserve for later use. Energy storage solutions for electricity generation include pumped-hydro storage, batteries, flywheels, compressed-air energy storage, hydrogen storage and thermal energy storage components.

Why do new energy power plants need energy storage?

Due to the uncertainty in the output of new energy power plants, there is a phenomenon of power curtailment during actual output. By configuring energy storage, new energy power plants can store the excess energy and discharge it when the output is insufficient, thus compensating for the power deficit.
