

Where are the Heard and McDonald Islands located?

The Heard and McDonald Islands are remote subantarctic volcanic features located in the Southern Ocean, halfway between Australia and South Africa. They are approximately 1700 km from the Antarctic continent and 4000 km southwest of mainland Australia (Australian Government 2016). Heard Island is 43 km long and 21 km wide.

What is the difference between Heard Island and McDonald Island?

Heard Island - 80% ice-covered, bleak and mountainous, dominated by a large massif (Big Ben) and an active volcano (Mawson Peak); McDonald Islands - small and rocky, Mawson Peak, an active volcano, is on Heard Island.

How big is Heard Island & McDonald Islands?

The group's overall land area is 372 km² (144 sq mi) and it has 101.9 km (63 mi) of coastline. Discovered in the mid-19th century, the islands lie on the Kerguelen Plateau in the Indian Ocean and have been an Australian territory since 1947. Heard Island and McDonald Islands contain Australia's only two active volcanoes.

Where is Heard Island in Australia?

These uninhabited, sub-Antarctic islands are located in the Southern Indian Ocean more than 2,500 miles southwest of Perth and about 2,400 miles from the nearest point on the Australian mainland, Cape Leeuwin.

Is Heard Island a volcano?

Heard Island makes up almost all the landmass of the territory and it's mostly covered in glaciers. The island is dominated by the massive Mawson Peak, a 9,000-foot active volcano. Mawson is also the highest peak of Australia, surpassing the 7,300-foot Mount Kosciuszko in New South Wales, the tallest mountain on the Australian mainland.

Who discovered Heard Island?

American sailor John HEARD discovered Heard Island in 1853 and thought it was a glacier that had broken away from Antarctica. Fellow American William MCDONALD discovered the McDonald Islands the following year.
