

Is New Caledonia part of the European Union?

New Caledonia is an overseas collectivity attached to the French Republic and associated with the European Union as an overseas country or territory (OCT), as provided for in Articles 198 to 204 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union. New Caledonia is made up of islands and archipelagos in the South Pacific Ocean.

What is New Caledonia's energy strategy?

New Caledonia, having embarked on this transition, is adopting an energy strategy in line with the Paris Agreement and the Green Deal focused on decarbonisation, green mobility and energy efficiency. In addition, the Territory will benefit from the Multiannual Indicative Programme (MIP) 2021-2027 for the Pacific OCTs.

Why is New Caledonia a French country?

New Caledonia is a territory sui generis to which France has gradually transferred certain powers. As such its citizens have French nationality and vote for the president of France. They have the right to vote in elections to the European Parliament.

Where does New Caledonia live?

Two thirds of New Caledonia's inhabitants live in the urban area of the capital, Nouméa. Its ground resources (nickel), financial transfers from the state and the European Union and local policies have enabled it to achieve a high level of development. Its internal organisation is governed by the Nouméa Accord.

What is New Caledonia's energy policy?

As a country of Oceania, one of the parts of the world most impacted by climate change, New Caledonia wishes to be exemplary in terms of energy policy. Building on the Paris Agreement, the Congress of New Caledonia adopted the Energetic Transition Scheme of New Caledonia (STENC) in June 2016. The scheme has three main objectives for 2030:

New Caledonia's economy is one of the most dynamic in French overseas territories, which is particularly related to underground resources: New Caledonia holds between 20% and 30% of the world's known nickel reserves. High productivity = high dependence?
