

## **Prius energy storage meter does not light up**

Why does my Prius light stay on?

Turn off your car and let it sit for 5-10 minutes. Then, try starting it back up again to reset it. If the light turns off, it may have been a system error and there isn't anything wrong with your car. However, if the light stays on, there may be a problem with your Prius.

What if my Toyota Prius has a maint reqd light?

If your Toyota Prius has a maintenance required light, have it brought in and maintained. Or, if you're the DIY type, ask your dealer for a print out of the exact schedule for your model year.

Will a Prius deplete the battery?

The Prius will never deplete the battery completely (not even close), nor will it let the battery get fully charged (somewhat close). However, the HV ECU will try to keep the battery SOC (State of Charge) at 6 bars when cruising.

What does the battery SoC display on the Prius mean?

The battery SOC display on the Prius is only showing you the portion of the battery's charge capacity that the Prius will actually use, which is about 40% of what the battery is really capable of. The Prius will never deplete the battery completely (not even close), nor will it let the battery get fully charged (somewhat close).

Yes I bet there used to be animations just like it a regular non plug-in Prius when you're driving down the road and you're charging braking or regen charging or whatever there should be lights on that display I do get that.

So I noticed today that the Energy Monitor system has stopped showing that the battery is powering the climate control system at all. It always showed previously, off an on of ...

The car was running great, no issues and no warning lights. I filled up on gas after 8 minutes of driving and when I tried to turn the car back on, the dashboard would not light up. In addition, the check engine light is on

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and the multi-information display has the hybrid system warning light on (little red car with !).

In my Owner's Manual (US version), this Meter, navigation system, instrument panel customization on p. 583 refers back to p. 181 which describes the Gauges and Meters (not the Auto Light on p. 206 which has to do with the headlights).

I noticed that the energy monitor does not work. The prius car display is there and the wheels are rolling but why is there no arrows coming out of the battery and the engine. Please help. Do i need to reset something? Im getting paranoid about this. hello everyone, it is my first ...

Reporting back on the Multifunction Display. This does not appear to be a fuse problem. The display came back on for some hours only to fade out again while driving leaving the buttons also unresponsive. Since then it has ...

I was working on a larger post about Prius plug-in conversion kits (come back soon for it) and this mini-rant I wrote up for the post did not quite fit here, so I made a separate post for it. Here is what the peculiarities are: The energy screen of the 2007 Prius has a battery charge bar indicator. What annoys me is that the indicator seems to ...

Likewise, if it's red/pink, that's not necessarily "bad." It just helps you recognize that it's either one or two bars higher than a 40% charge. As for the colors of the energy-flow arrows, those too are to help you see the energy flow without having to make note of the tiny little arrowheads while in traffic.

I replaced that fuse and power came back on when pushing the start button BUT with the red triangle lit along with almost all other warning lights, including brake light and a little red car icon with exclamation sign on the LCD ...

It typically comes on when putting the lights on first and then starting. But there were a day or two when it wouldn't come on at all. Still if it keeps coming on, I get the caps are dead, however, there would appear to be some way to get it ...

In your case, it might be the sensor went bad. Toyota dealer called it the thermistor. You can test it by detaching from the 2-wire connector, ...

I have a Prius 2008 with 7000 miles. Several times when the power button is pushed to start the car the instrument panel does not light up. The ready light is on and the car runs perfectly. When my wife started the car the other day the instrument panel did not light up, but when she started driving the panel came on.

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The Check Engine Light (CEL) or Malfunction Indicator Light (MIL) on the Gen2 Prius is a LED in the Combo Meter assembly. It gets power from the 7.5 amp IGN fuse in the driver's side junction/fuse box and the ECM provides ground if it want to turn it on. You need the service manual for the wiring diagrams and connector pinouts and locations.

I have a 2007 Prius (~11000 miles), and the battery meter never completely fills to the top (i.e. all ~8 green bars). ... The regen that charges the battery does not happen just because you are going downhill, it only occurs when you use the brakes. 2001 Prius/2007 Prius. ... However I would agree that you get a better recoup of energy with ...

For some reason the Energy monitor screen isn't displaying the usual activity while driving - i.e. no arrows showing when HV Battery is charging/discharging etc. Is this normal? ...

I drove it about 2 miles to a friends house this morning, and it worked normally, but 10 minutes later, I get in it again, to go grocery shopping, and my HUD or combination meter, or whatever it is you call the electronic display that shows gear, gas, speed, mileage, check engine light, etc, does not work.

The likely reason like my 2009 Prius dashboard not lighting up on start up is the electrical connections from the dashboard to the main computer has gotten oxidized not making a good connection. The way I fixed this was to ...

I have a 2009 Prius Gen 2 that the display is wonky at best regularly I get in the car and have no speedometer gas gauge none of the orange lights that are always on are not on just to check engine light and everything is blank the check engine light is unrelated to the no display the display is not the capacitor because my display will always return if I sit there and play in ...

The title of the thread clearing reads "Dash not lighting up. Instrument panel no speedo etc", nowhere does it state anything about the car NOT running or driving. If the car was not running or driving, (which would be a much greater issue) it would been the MAIN focus of my question and mentioned first and the post titled completely different.

It is not a problem with starting - it is a problem turning off. As for the dash display it isn't a problem with the dimmer switch. When the dash lights don't work - the panel in the center console that displays mpg/radio/heat still is lit - but it appears maybe the computer isn't sending any info because it can't even register any fuel efficiency or trip info.

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However, in the HV System Indicator, the EV light is off (even though I'm in EV mode), which indicates that the ICE is indeed running. What gives? I have seen lags on the ...

I was trying to find out how to show the Energy Monitor on the main screen, but I am unable to do so. According to all the manuals, including the one that came with the car, ...

According to the Toyota service information if, "Multi-information display does not light up (Combination meter assembly operates normally)." then "Combination Meter Assembly (Multi-information Display)" [is bad] OR "Combination Meter Assembly (No. 3 ...

My 2008 Prius dashboard lights/indicator lights are not turning on. The car seems to turn on fine. It's not the lights - I've turned on the headlights - they turn on. I've tried turning the dimmer on and off and they work for the ...

As for the OP, my understanding of the Energy Monitor from a gen2 is that it shows where the energy is flowing to and from, not what component is on. The car appears parked in the photos. If not in drive, energy can't flow ...

What may help is to keep track of your MPG over time. If you are getting unusually low values, then you need the documentation. if your values are normal, then maybe there is ...

This morning I tried to drive my 2008 Prius and the "check engine" light quickly blinked and the dashboard didn't light up. The monitor did turn on and I could hear the engine running. The monitor showed that the hybrid battery was almost full. While trying to go in reverse, the camera did not work. We just had an oil change done.
