

What is M-kopa Solar?

In just under three years M-KOPA Solar has provided affordable energy to over 200,000 homes in Kenya, Tanzania and Uganda. They have been so successful that in some cases those who were previously off grid have been supplying power to people on the main electrical grid during the frequent power outages.

Can M-kopa Solar provide cheap solar power to rural homes?

How does M-Kopa work?

The M-KOPA systems are bought for a small price, and customers purchase daily credit using M-Pesa's mobile money payment system. After a year each customer owns their system outright and they no longer have to pay for power.

Where is M-Kopa based?

M-Kopa expanded from its east African base to Nigeria in 2021 and has more recently started operations in Ghana. It is testing the market in South Africa and also running pilot projects to finance electric motorbikes as part of a new e-mobility strategy.

Is M-Kopa a kerosene-free energy provider?

M-Kopa -- which calls itself "the world's leading pay-as-you-go energy provider to off-grid homes" -- estimates it has saved \$206-million for the 300,000 households and businesses that use its products, while giving them 34 million hours of kerosene-free lighting a month.

How does M-Pesa work in Africa?

It's a perfect off-the-grid solar system for Africa, where land-based infrastructure is poor and electricity supply is frequently erratic. For a deposit of \$35, buyers get the system then make 365 daily payments of \$0.43 through mobile money system M-Pesa. When it is all paid off, the system belongs to the buyer outright.

M-KOPA was founded in 2010 on the idea that combining digital micropayments with GSM connectivity could provide affordable access to life-enhancing products. Since then, we've built a financial platform that has deployed over \$1.5 billion in credit and enabled over 5 million customers across five countries - Kenya, Uganda, Nigeria, Ghana and ...
