

Will Uzbekistan have a battery energy storage system?

ADB said it will be one of the first utility-scale renewable energy projects with a battery energy storage system (BESS) component in Uzbekistan. It follows the announcement of the country's first BESS in May 2024 and the connection of the first phase of a 511 MW solar project in March of this year.

What is Uzbekistan's solar energy vision?

It outlines the sustainable energy environment solar energy could deliver and offers a timeline up to 2030. In this vision, Uzbekistan succeeds in maximising the benefits of solar energy capacity for both electricity and heat, making solar energy one of the country's major energy sources.

Will Uzbekistan build a solar-plus-battery system?

The ADB is proposing a large scale, solar-plus-battery system in Uzbekistan. According to a listing on ADB's website, the Samarkand 1 Solar PV and BESS Project will involve the construction of two solar power plants, of 100 MW and 400 MW, a pooling station, 500 MWh BESS, loop-in loop-out transmission lines, and a 70 km overhead transmission line.

Does Uzbekistan have a solar plant?

Separately, ACWA Power recently announced financial close on a 200 MW solar plant and 500 MWh BESS near the national capital, Tashkent. Uzbekistan had 253 MW of cumulative installed solar capacity at the end of last year, according to figures from the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA).

Will Uzbekistan have a solar power grid?

For instance, the UAE's state-owned Masdar added 511 MW of photovoltaic projects to Uzbekistan's grid in March and, in January, expanded its partnership with the Uzbek government to develop 500 MWh of battery storage and 2 GW of wind energy. Uzbekistan aims for 12 GW of renewable capacity by 2030, with 7 GW from solar PV.

Will Uzbekistan reach its maximum capacity of solar energy?

Nevertheless, a more comprehensive set of policies and support mechanisms will be required to reach Uzbekistan's maximum capacity of solar energy and further increase solar energy toward 2030. The government should consider bundling the range of actions needed to ensure the use of all types of solar energy resources.

French renewables company Voltalia SA (EPA: VLTSA), UAE's Masdar and a consortium of GD Power and Powerchina have been selected in a tender in Uzbekistan to build three solar parks in the Central Asian country with a combined capacity of 500 MW.

In May, Nur Bukhara Solar PV LLC FE, a project company owned by Masdar, set out to build a 63 MW battery energy storage system alongside a 250 MW solar plant in the Alat district of the Bukhara region, billed as Uzbekistan's first big BESS project. Most major announcements, however, came from the Saudi Arabian developer itself.

Another Middle Eastern developer, Saudi Arabia's ACWA Power, signed agreements to develop 1.2GW of energy storage in the country as well as 1.4GW of solar in March last year, while during a state visit to Uzbekistan by French president Emmanuel Macron, France-headquartered developer Voltalia signed agreements to progress a hybrid solar-wind ...
