

Can Tonga achieve 100 per cent access to electricity?

Achieving universal access to electricity is a priority for the Government of Tonga. The Tonga Energy Roadmap (TERM) states that Tonga should achieve 100 per cent access to electricity by 2020 (Government of Tonga, 2010). Achievement of this target is crucial to meet the Government's primary target of "poverty alleviation".

Why is energy important in Tonga?

As an island nation, energy is a critical input to the wellbeing and economy of the country, underpinning its trade, transport and services. Tonga's Sustainable Development Goal 7 Road Map highlights that good progress has been made on many of the targets of SDG7.

How many people are without electricity in Tonga?

National energy profile Universal access to electricity in Tonga was reported as 96 per cent in 2018, based on data from Ministry of Meteorology, Energy Information, Disaster management, Environment, Climate Change and Communications (MEIDECC), leaving 4,026 people without electricity access.

The two battery storage facilities installed in Tonga are complementary: the aim of the first 5 MWh / 10 MW battery is to improve the electricity grid's stability (regulating the voltage and frequency), while the second 23 MWh / 7 MW battery is designed to transfer the electrical load in order to help the grid supply electricity at peak times, and notably in the evening.
